Unlocking Value in Workplace Exposure and Medical Surveillance Data

Employee health management is a basic tenet of business management and administration. Several legislative frameworks and requirements to this effect are in place and ultimately result in the generation and accumulation of workplace exposure and medical surveillance data in the target business enterprises.

The accumulated data should not be viewed only as a necessary but somewhat annoying outcome of adherence to legal requirements, but as a valuable enterprise-specific information resource. Unprocessed data cannot readily paint an accessible picture of workplace exposure, risks and the success of interventions to limit exposure and risks. Data organisation, processing, analysis and reporting unlocks the hidden value and provides clear information allowing strategized planning and management of the protection of worker health and business liabilities.
